Community fire committees, can help with information and fire fighting




Maintain fire points with buckets, sand, and fire beaters



Practice the best way to escape if your tent catches fire

IN CASE OF FIRE


If your clothes catch fire



STOP where you are - DROP to the ground - ROLL to extinguish the flames

Running will spread the flames


If your tent is on fire



Check that there is no-one inside THEN Knock down the shelter and nearby shelters

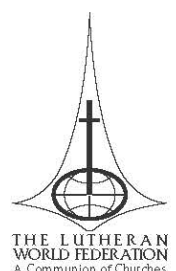
This will help stop the fire from spreading

burns



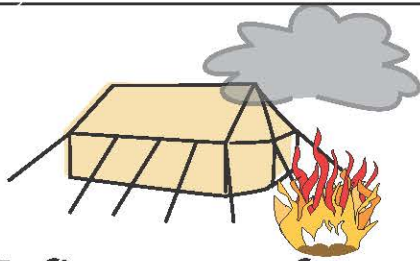
Cool the burn area with cold water or a wet cloth immediately.

Then seek medical attention



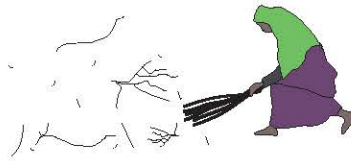

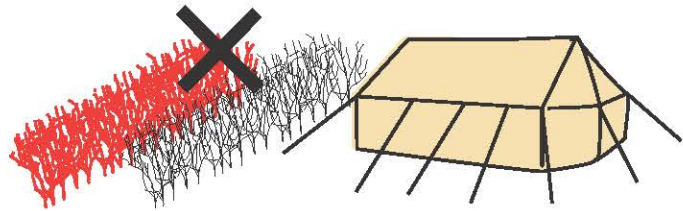
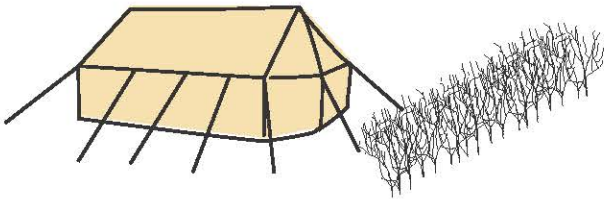


KEEP fire away from tents

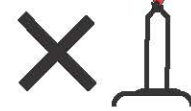
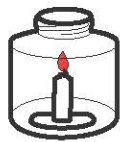
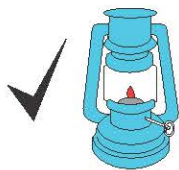
With wind, it can spread very easily



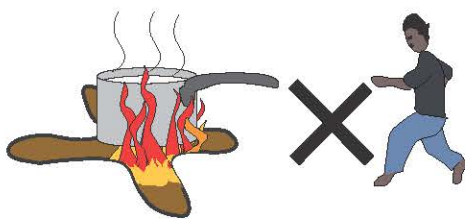
Good housekeeping!



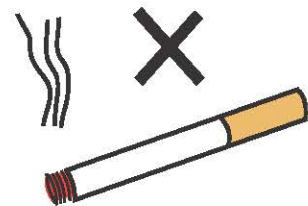
Do not encroach on firebreaks

Be Careful! Candles and lamps must be protected in lamps or in jars



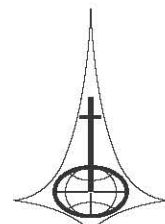
Keep children away from hot cooking pots
