BEFORE

1



Store an adequate supply of food and clean water.



Always keep yourself updated with the latest weather report.



Harvest crops that can be yielded already.



For fisher folks, place boats in a safe area.



Keep flashlights, candles and battery-powered within easy reach.



Examine your house and repair its parts.



Secure animals in a safe place.



Should you need to evacuate, bring clothes, first aid kit, etc.

Stay inside a safe building



Always keep yourself updated with the latest weather report.



Boil water for a least 20 minutes. Safe drinking water in a container with cover.



Keep an eye on lighted candles or gas lamp.



Do not wade through floodwaters to avoid being electrocuted and contracting disease.

AFTER

Make sure that your house is stable when you enter.



Beware of dangerous animals that may have entered your house.



Watch out for live wires or outlet immersed in water.



Report damaged electrical cables and fallen electric posts to officers.



To avoid creating a favorable condition for mosquito breeding. Do not let water gather.
